### WHEN TO APPLY

- Apply before wildfire season (late spring/early summer) when vegetation is dry but fire risk is low. Effective up to 3 months in dry conditions, or until >2 inches of rain, then reapply.

### WHERE TO USE

- Homes & structures: Vegetation within 0–5 ft of buildings
- Vegetation: Shrubs, trees, ground cover, pine needles, dry grass
- Wooden structures: Sheds, decks, fences, roofs
- Flammable materials: Bark, mulch, firewood piles
- Critical assets: Trees, fences, power poles, utility equipment

### HOW TO APPLY

Mix 1:1 with water and spray evenly using a garden or backpack sprayer  
Reapply after heavy rain.

01

Use garden sprayers, backpack sprayers, or larger spray equipment depending on area size

02

Mixing ratio 1:1 (Water : Concentrate)

03

Apply evenly to coat vegetation and surfaces, forming a protective barrier against ignition

04

For wildfire management, Clore can also be used to:

- Reinforce control lines (roads, mineral soil, or containment features).
- Prevent spotting (lighter spray outside main control line).
- Reduce flame length and intensity inside burn areas.
- Create fire buffers where soil clearing isn't feasible

### Safety Precautions

Wear gloves, goggles, and mask.  
Avoid spraying on copper or stain-prone surfaces. Triple rinse equipment after use to prevent clogging/corrosion.
